Further, it is our intent to hold greater than \$2,000 in market value through the next annual meeting of Coca-Cola. Our custodian will gladly provide certification of our ownership if requested by you.


I hereby notify you that UUSC, as a concerned shareholder, intends to cofile the enclosed Water Study and Report resolution in concert with other institutions, led by Sr. Gwen Ferry of the Sisters of the Blessed Virgin Mary (BVM).

The resolution is submitted for consideration and action by the stockholders at the next annual meeting and for inclusion in the proxy statement under Rule 14 a-8 of the general rules and regulations of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934. We would appreciate your indicating in your proxy statement that UUSC is a sponsor of this resolution. We will be represented in person or by proxy at the annual meeting. If there are differences between this resolution and that of the primary filer, we accept the resolution of the primary filer.

For more than 65 years, UUSC has advanced human rights and social justice in the United States and around the world. In order to pursue these goals, we partner with a number of grassroots organizations. Representatives of these partners tell us of the great need for global corporations to be responsive to the needs of local communities where they have their plants and facilities, and to adopt and implement company-wide policies and practices which protect human rights, the just treatment of employees, and which also sustain the environment. In these times of shrinking sources of potable water, the human right to access safe, affordable, sufficient water for daily needs is of critical concern to us and to our partners.

Therefore, as a shareholder of the Coca-Cola Company, we urge the Board of Directors to commission a study by an independent third party organization on the potential environmental and public health damage of all of its plants, affiliates and proposed ventures extracting water from areas of water scarcity in India.
